Impact on Adult Learning

- Working with Literacy Source, offered 50 virtual English Circle sessions, with an attendance of more than 1,030.
- Added access to Northstar Digital Literacy.
- Partnered with Seattle Housing Authority to offer digital literacy training to 51 residents.
- Around 250 people attended Your Next Job appointments.
- Teens from the Rainier Vista and New Holly neighborhoods gained workforce development skills during paid summer internships.
- Created more than 175 virtual programs for older adults.

Impact on Local Businesses

- Held more than 280 virtual one-on-one help sessions.
- Worked with community partners to develop more than 100 virtual events that reached around 1,900 people.
- Offered free access to legal professionals through 24 consults.
- Offered other networking opportunities, with live translation available in Spanish, Vietnamese, Somali, Amharic and Mandarin.

Impact on Student Success

- Students participated in over 3,000 virtual tutoring sessions through tutor.com.
- Collaborated with six community agencies and the Seattle Housing Authority to co-design K-5 Library programs and services that reached more than 480 youth and families.
- More than 1,600 students participated in a virtual Global Reading Challenge.
- Offered 95 different virtual story times.
- With a theme of "What's Your Story?," the 2021 Summer of Learning program distributed over 25,000 posters.
- Partnered with more than 70 community-based organizations to distribute more than 14,000 books to more than 10,000 youth.

Providing Access During COVID-19

- In the first quarter of 2021, the Library increased locations with Curbside Service from 11 to 15 and book return locations from 13 to 19.
- In April 2021, we began reopening Library locations. By the end of October 2021, we had reopened all 27 libraries.
- During a record-breaking triple-digit heat wave that hit Seattle in June 2021, expanded open hours at air-conditioned locations and provided respite to thousands of Seattle residents.
- The Library offered a total of 1,335 hot spots to the community, including 775 loaned through our catalog and 325 "outreach" hot spots.

Impact on Cultural & Civic Engagement

- The Library hosted nearly 50 digital author programs in 2021.
- Invited two guest curators to create literature/ humanities-related programs on behalf of the Library.
- More than 8,000 people participated in Seattle Reads programming around Brit Bennett's bestselling novel "The Vanishing Half."
- Other 2021 programs included art-centered vaccine clinics, a multi-arts workshop called Art Club with Solid Ground Housing, and the sixth annual Legendary Children event.
- Partnered with Earshot Jazz to create a comprehensive digital collection of its archives.
- Successfully completed conservation work on the Douglass-Truth Branch's historic Soul Pole sculpture.
